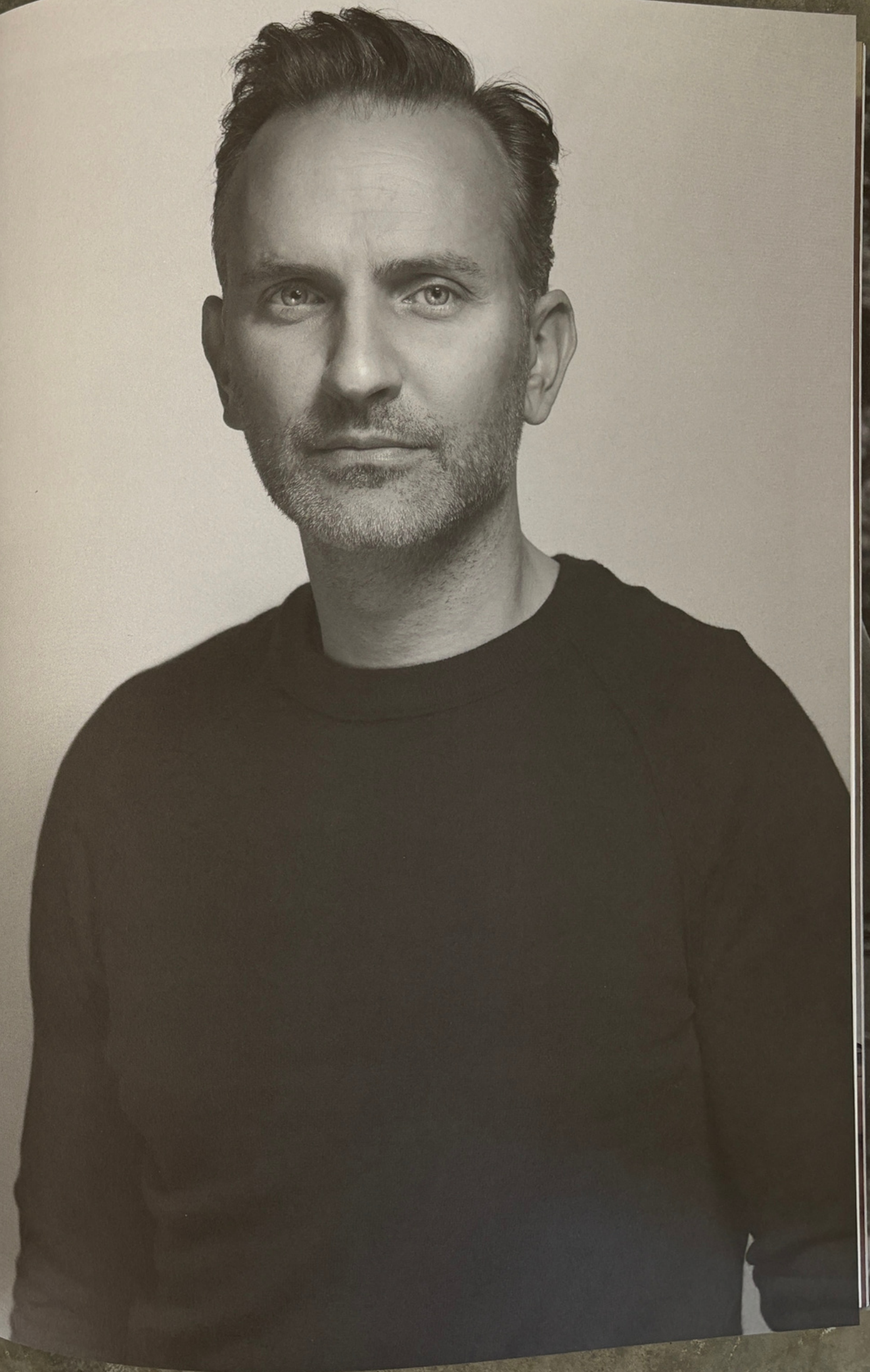


OKYO

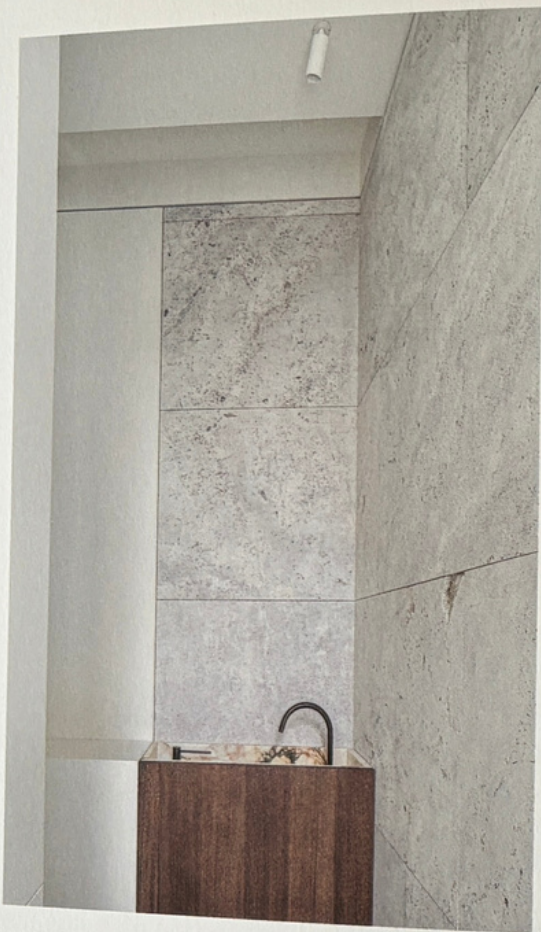

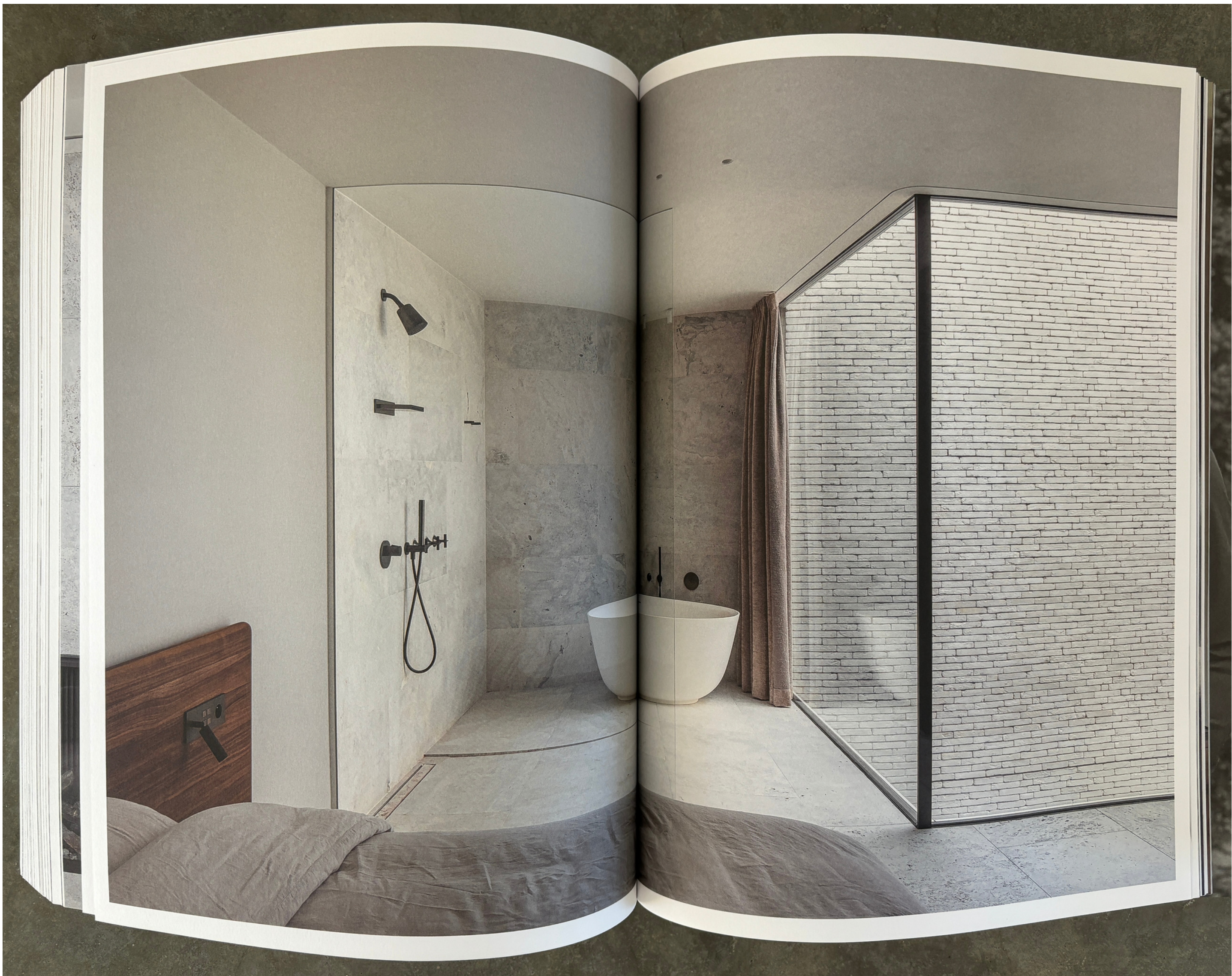
